Venue: The Sublette County Library Gallery Space in Pinedale, February 2021

Two-Dimensional Art Requirements:

Paintings, Drawings, Quilts, and Photographs are acceptable -- no larger than 36 inches on any side. Small 3-dimensional items may be accepted but only with pre-approval due to space limitations.

The following written information is required before January 15th, 2021 to be inserted into the program and to accompany the hanging art: Artist Name, Medium, Title, and a brief Description of how the artist is using the artwork to convey the theme. In addition, the artwork may be identified for sale: marked on submitted information either - Not for Sale (NFS) or For Sale with price determined by the artist. The Sublette County Library will accept donations in lieu of a pre-determined gallery fee.

There is no entry fee for this event.

Submissions must be dry and ready for hanging, with a suitable frame and wire (for quilts, a rod pocket with centrally attached D ring is suitable). Sawtooth hangers are not acceptable.

Artwork to be delivered to the Library between 10 am and 12 Noon on February 1st, 2021, or by prior arrangement.

If Artwork is to be mailed, please contact the event coordinators prior to the event for acceptance, mailing address or other information. A return pre-paid mailing label is also required unless the artist will pick it up in person at the end of the February show. The artist bears all liability for mailing or shipping and should provide their own insurance for mailing or shipping purposes.
